At Knox, in our K-2 Centre we have a group of dedicated, vibrant and professional teachers who will have your child's best interests at heart and who are determined to get the best out of every boy.

Our main aim in the K-2 centre is to have the children happy to come to school and eager to learn. We want your son to be enthusiastic and cheerful about school and learning.

We want him to feel secure and safe in his school environment; content and comfortable with the adults around him. **If we have achieved this, we have a child who is receptive to learning.** If a child is unhappy, worried or insecure, he won't be ready to learn so the most important thing for us is to make your child feel valued, secure and excited to come to school.

We aim to provide a solid foundation in literacy and numeracy at an early age ... the more secure the foundations, the stronger the building at later stages of your son's schooling. From Kindergarten, boys are involved in all key learning areas - English, Mathematics, Science and Technology, Human Society and its Environment, Creative Arts, Personal Development, Health and Physical Education and Religious Education. Computers are in every classroom and from Year 2 the boys learn a second language.

School is a busy place. Our boys are constantly involved in learning experiences inside and outside the classroom. The boys are part of a caring environment where everyone is encouraged to 'have a go'.
